CENTRAL HINDI COMMITTEE

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Central Hindi Committee has set up three committees for monitoring the proper use of Hindi;
- (b) if so, whether these committees have presented their reports;
- (c) if not, the time by which these are likely to be presented; and
- (d) the date on which the meeting of Central Hindi Committee is likely to be held again and the time by which the reports are likely to be approved?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (I.D. SWAMI)

(a) to (d): In a meeting of the Kendriya Hindi Samiti held under the Chairmanship of Hon`ble Prime Minister on 22 Sep. 2000, it was decided that two Sub-Committees will be constituted to consider the views of the members of the Committee. Accordingly, two Sub-Committees under the Chairmanship of Hon`ble Home Minister and Hon`ble Human Resource Minister have since been constituted on 07 November, 2000. These Sub-Committees will prepare their reports within six months and submit the same in the next meeting of the Kendriya Hindi Samiti. The date for the next meeting of the Kendriya Hindi Samiti has not yet been fixed.
