

## Achievements of the Department of Official Language for February, 2019

- (i) Rajbhasha Conference was organized for the south and southwest region in Kochi under the chairmanship of Secretary (Rajbhasha) On the 14th February, 2019, in which the honorable Governor of Kerala was the chief guest.
- (ii) Meetings of 32 Town Official Language Implementation Committees were organized in different cities of the country in which the implementation of the Official Language Policy and the compliance of the executive orders issued in this regard and measures to improve it are discussed.
- (iii) 10 Hindi computer training programs were organized in various cities of the country through the Central Hindi Training Institute by the Department of Official Language.
- (iv) 49 complaints were disposed off the department in February, 2019.
- (v) 477<sup>th</sup> Intensive Hindi Workshop was organized, from 04.02.2019 to 08.02.2019, in which 35 officers/employees participated.
- (vi) Central Translation Bureau has organized 01 Training Program in February 2019, in which 22 trainees were trained.
- (vii) Translated material of 297 standard pages in February, 2019 was dispatched to various ministries/departments.
- (viii) The annual program 2019-20 was prepared and uploaded on the official website of the department of Official Language.
- (ix) The Calendar and Diary of year 2019 of the department of Official Language was printed from DAVP, and distributed to all the ministries / departments under the Government of India along with dignitaries in the country.
- (x) Messages of Hon'ble Home Minister/ Secretary/ Joint Secretary for various in-house Magazines were prepared and sent.
- (xi) The nomenclature of junior and senior translators was changed.
- (xii) Two candidates among 102 candidates who were successful in the examination conducted by the Staff Selection Commission in 2017 for the junior translator of the Central Secretariat Official Language Service Cadre were given appointment.
