Main achievements of the Department of Official Language in January, 2018

- 1. Regional Official Language Conference was organized for the Central and Western Region in Mumbai on 12-01-2018 under the chairmanship of Secretary (Official Language). Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra Shri C.V Rao was the Chief Guest at the Conference.
- 2. Meetings of 67 Town Official Language Implementation Committees were organized in various cities of the country in which the implementation of the Official Language Policy and the compliance of the executive orders issued in this regard and measures to improve it are discussed.
- 3. All 144 complaints were disposed off in the month of January, 2018 in the Department.
- 4. After the approval of Union Public Service Commission one Deputy Director of Central Secretariat Official Language Service was given regular promotion to the post of Joint Director.
- 5. The Department of Official Language organised 12 Hindi computer training programs in different cities of the country through the Central Hindi Training Institute.
- 6. Messages were prepared and sent from Secretary/Joint Secretary for various in house Magazines.
- 7. Six training programs were conducted by the Central Translation Bureau in January 2018 in which 137 trainees were trained.
- 8. Translated materials of 3260 standard pages in January 2018 were dispatched to different Ministries/Departments.
- 9. Workshop unit of Central Hindi Training Institute situated at Prithviraj Road, New Delhi organised 461st Intensive Hindi Workshop from 08/01/2018 to 12/01/2018 in which 40 personnel participated.
- 10. All India level exam of Hindi Typing/Hindi Stenography was conducted by Deputy Director(Examination) in January, 2018.
- 11. Intensive Praveen Online Exam was conducted at Vadodara centre by Deputy Director (Examination).

- 12. The three sub committees of Committee of Parliament on Official Language conducted Official Language inspection meetings of 62 Ministries/Departments/subordinate offices during January 2018.
- 13. Copies of Annual Assessment Report 2016-17 were sent to all Ministries/ Departments of Govt of India/TOLICs.
