

# **Main achievements of the Department of Official Language for March, 2018**

1. Regional Official Language Conference was organized for the East and North Eastern Region in Patna on 10-03-2018 under the chairmanship of Secretary (Official Language). Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs Shri Kiren Rijiju was the Chief Guest at the Conference.
2. On March 26, 2018, a meeting was held in the NDMC Convention Centre under the chairmanship of Secretary (Official Language) along with other organizations such as Microsoft/Google for promotion of Hindi in which advance strategy was made in order to make various Hindi fonts Unicode enabled.
3. Annual Program 2018-19 of the Department of Official Language was prepared and uploaded to the department's website after the approval and signature of the Hon'ble Minister of Home Affairs and was given in the press for printing.
4. Diary and calendars of the year 2018 of the Department of Official Language was were distributed among all the Ministries/Departments, banks and undertakings including Hon'ble President, Vice-President, Prime Minister, Union Ministers, Governors of States, Members of Parliament and Higher officials of the Government of India.
5. 1000 copies of compilation of orders issued by the President on the first 9 parts of the Report of the Committee of Parliament on Official language was published and their distribution work was commenced.
6. Meetings of 26 Town Official Language Implementation Committees were organized in various cities of the country in which the implementation of the Official Language Policy and the compliance of the executive orders issued in this regard and measures to improve it are discussed.
7. The review work on the formation and functions of the Town Official Language Implementation Committees was carried out.
8. All 82 complaints were settled in the month of March, 2018 in the Department.
9. 463th Intensive Hindi Workshops were organized by the workshop unit of the Institute from 05/03/2018 to 09/03/2018 in which 45 personnel participated.

10. Orientation training program was organized by the workshop unit of the Institute from 19/03/2018 to 23/03/2018, in which 23 participants participated.
11. The Department of Official Language organised 03 Hindi computer training programs in different cities of the country through the Central Hindi Training Institute.
12. Messages prepared and sent from Hon'ble Home Minister/Secretary/Joint Secretary for various in house Magazines.
13. Two training programs were conducted by the Central Translation Bureau in March 2018 in which 42 trainees were trained.
14. Translated materials of 7,067 standard pages in March 2018 were dispatched to different Ministries/Departments.
15. Proposals for promotion of 5 Deputy Directors (Official Language) to the post of Joint Director (OL) were sent to Union Public Service Commission.
