

Main achievements of the Department of Official Language, November 2018

- (i) Rajbhsaha Conference was organized in Chandigarh for North-1 and North-2 region on 19.11.2018, in which Union Minister of State for Home, Honourable Sh. Kiren Rijju was the Chief Guest.
- (ii) State Level Implementation Review and Technical Seminar was organized in Agartala (Tripura) under the chairmanship of Joint Secretary (Official Language) on 13th November, 2018.
- (iii) Department of Official Language has celebrated 'Constitution Day' under the chairmanship of Deputy Secretary (Official Language), on 26.11.2018 in which the Preamble of the Constitution of India was taught to all the officials/employees of the Department of Official Language.
- (iv) Meetings of 76 Town Official Language Implementation Committees were organized in different cities of the country in which the implementation of the Official Language Policy and the compliance of the executive orders issued in this regard and measures to improve it are discussed.
- (v) 03 Hindi computer training programs were organized in different cities of the country through the Central Hindi Training Institute organized by the Department of Official Language.
- (vi) The Annual Report of the Rajbhasha Vibhag of the year 2017-18 was obtained from the Government of India printing press and sent to the publication counter of Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha and office of PIB. In addition, copies of this were forwarded to all the Ministries / Departments of the Government of India.
- (vii) 65 complaints were disposed off in the department in November, 2018
- (viii) Intensive Hindi workshops were organized from 12.11.2018 to 16.11.2018 and from 26.11.2018 to 30.11.2018, in which 39 and 41 officers / employees participated.
- (ix) Special classes for Pragya has been started by the Deputy Director (north-central) from 14.11.2018 to 07.12.2018, in the Office of the Accountant General (Audit), Jammu Office, Srinagar, in which 21 candidates were trained.
- (x) 01 Training Program was organized by the Central Translation Bureau in November, 2018, in which 18 trainees were trained.
- (xi) Translated materials of 445 standard pages were dispatched to various ministries / departments in November, 2018.
- (xii) Messages of Hon'ble Home Minister/Secretary/Joint Secretary for different Home Journals were prepared and sent.
- (xiii) The ad hoc period of 14 ad-hoc Senior Translators was given extension according to the order of the Department of Personnel and Training and informed to the concerned Ministries / Departments.
- (xiv) 56 Senior Translators were promoted to the post of Assistant Director against the vacancies of the year 2016-17.
