

Major achievements of the Department of Official Language for the month of August, 2020

- (1) The Department carried out total 93 E-inspections and 93 TOLIC E-meetings through video-conferencing. In addition, there was our online participation in 11 E-webinars. The overall objective of these online efforts by the Department was to promote Official Language Hindi.
- (2) Department of Official Language has started translation competition through memory based translation tool Kanthasth in government organisations all over India from 22 August 2020. The competition is being conducted through online mode only and participants from all over India are participating from their organisations itself.
- (3) During the translation competition, two organisations (ONGC and Central Bank of India) were given online training of Kanthasth.
- (4) As per the directions of MHA, Department of Official Language set up an Awards Cell and the complete information (Within the time limit of August) regarding awards was sent to DG (Awards) in MHA.
- (5) The book selection Committee declared 2 'Rajbhasha Kirti Awards' for in-house magazines in 'A', 'B' and 'C' region for each year 2018-19 and 2019-20 respectively.
- (6) The selection committee declared 3 'Rajbhasha Gaurav Awards' each for the year 2018-19 and 2019-20 for outstanding articles published in the magazines by the Central Government Officers/Employees belonging to Hindi regions and other than Hindi regions.
- (7) Short-Term Intensive Training Unit conducted 499th online intensive Hindi workshop from 03.08.2020 to 07.08.2020, in which 21 employees participated.
- (8) Short-Term Intensive Training Unit organised a training programme for trainers in which an online intensive Hindi workshop was conducted from 17.08.2020 to 21.08.2020. Total 9 employees participated in this workshop.
- (9) Under the directions of the Department of Official Language, Central Hindi Training Institute started all India level online Hindi Language/Hindi Typing/Hindi Stenography training at training centres of Hindi Teaching Scheme/Central Hindi Training Institute/Sub Institutes through Microsoft Teams App.
- (10) 506 trainees were nominated in the 60th Session of Hindi Typing/Word Processing and Personal Contact Programmes were organised through Microsoft Teams App in Bengaluru, Kolkata, Secundrabad and Mumbai.
- (11) 04 training programs were conducted by the Central Translation Bureau, in which 115 trainees participated.

- (12) Central Translation Bureau translated a total of 2147 standard pages.
- (13) 41 complaints were disposed of in the department.
- (14) Printed copies of The Annual Report for the year 2019-20 were received from the press and dispatched to various Ministries.
- (15) 15 Joint Directors of the Central Secretariat Official Language Service were promoted to the post of Director on ad-hoc basis.
- (16) The Parliament Committee on Official Language carried out inspection of 10 offices.
