

## **Major achievements of the Department of Official Language for the month of December, 2020**

- (1) To fulfil the statutory obligations related with Rajbhasha Hindi, its propagation and spread continued even during the Corona pandemic. In continuation of the same, Secretary, Rajbhasha addressed the Hindi seminars held in NTPC on 07 December, 2020; in Power Grid on 09 December, 2020; in Steel Authority of India on 14 December, 2020; in DRDO on 16 December, 2020 and in NHPC, Delhi on 22 December, 2020 through which he inspired the senior officers along with other officers/personnel to do their day to day work in Hindi. In these workshops; Secretary, Rajbhasha highlighted ten 'P's ( Prayatna i.e. attempt, Prerana i.e. inspiration, Protsahan i.e. encouragement, Prem i.e. love, Prize or Puraskar i.e. award, Prashikshan i.e. training, Prayog i.e. application, Prachar-Prasar i.e. propagation-promotion, Prabandhan i.e. management and Prayas i.e. effort) based on the mnemonics of Prime Minister.
- (2) A total of 77 E-inspections, 86 E-meetings and 46 other meetings/webinars were held online by regional implementation offices of Department of Official Language.
- (3) The number of sentences have now increased to 5,93,207 in memory based translation tool "Kanthasth".
- (4) 53 complaints were disposed off in department.
- (5) Employees of Central Hindi Training Institute/Hindi Teaching Scheme participated in a day long online training on cyber security.
- (6) 52 offices situated in Delhi were inspected by three sub-committees of Committee of Parliament on Official Language.
- (7) 05 crash translation training programmes and 01 short term translation training programme were conducted by Central Translation Bureau and its centres. A total of 196 trainees participated in these training programmes.
- (8) Central Translation Bureau translated 1361 standard pages in the month of December.
- (9) 169 candidates succeeded in the examination conducted in the year 2019 by Staff Selection Commission for Junior Translation Officers of Central Secretariat Official Language Service, out of which dossiers of 103 candidates were sent to various Ministries/Departments.
- (10) Proposal for filling up the posts of Assistant Director through promotion against the vacancies of 2019 and 2020 was sent to UPSC.
