

Major achievements of the Department of Official Language for the month of November, 2020

- (1) Senior officers of the status of joint secretary level and Rajbhasha officers of Ministries/Departments participated in the 42nd COLIC meeting conducted between 02 Nov, 2020 to 05 Nov, 2020. Keeping in view the present Covid-19 Pandemic situation and to maintain social distancing, the meeting with all the 79 participating Ministries was organised in 4 days @ per day two sessions First Phase (Forenoon 10.30-12.00) and Second Phase (Afternoon 02-30-4.00). In this meeting, the actions taken by the Ministries/Departments regarding the implementation of official language was reviewed and the expected corrective measures were discussed.
- (2) A total of 70 E-inspections, 65 E-meetings and 17 other meetings/webinar were conducted online by regional implementation offices of Department of Official Language.
- (3) Secretary, Rajbhasha put forth his views as chief guest on the subject "Bhasha Vigyan vs Rajbhasha:Vartman Dasha aur Disha" organised by Ministry of Earth Sciences on 24 November, 2020.
- (4) Secretary, Rajbhasha addressed the Rajbhasha conference organised by the Airports Authority of India on 26 November, 2020 under the auspices of Town official language implementation committee (undertaking-1)
- (5) 44 complaints were resolved in department.
- (6) Online Hindi workshops were organised by Central Hindi Training Institute from 02 November to 06 November and again from 16 November to 20 November 2020 in which 22 and 09 employees participated respectively.
- (7) Complying with the guidelines for prevention of Covid-19, Hindi bhasha and Hindi typewriting examinations were organised successfully at all India level on 23, 24, 25 and 26 November, 2020 at different examination centres by Central Hindi Training Institute under Hindi Teaching Scheme.
- (8) 75 offices were inspected by three sub-committees of Committee of Parliament on Official Language.
- (9) 3000 copies of 158th issue of the hindi magazine "Rajbhasha Bharati" were distributed all over India by hand and by post.
- (10) Central Translation Bureau and its centres organised a crash translation training programme (Two and half hours) and 2 Short term Translation Training programmes (5 days). 72 trainees participated in these programmes.
- (11) 1745 standard pages were translated by Central Translation Bureau in the month of November.
